



UCSB Adventure Programs Campus Point Rentals

Details | Special Considerations | Requirements



We are glad that you are interested in renting a kayak, Stand Up Paddleboard (SUP) and surf gear from the Campus Point Rental Center. Please read all this information thoroughly.

Location: The UCSB Adventure Programs Campus Point Rentals is located at UCSB Campus Point right at the beach.

Hours: Please check our website (<http://recreation.sa.ucsb.edu/facilities/rentals/outdoor-gear-rentals>) for current hours. We are closed during University holidays and inclement weather. Hours change quarterly based on demand and staffing. Please double check.

What you need: UCSB Students will be required to present a current UCSB Access Card in order to receive student pricing. All others will be required to present a current government issued ID. Payments can be made with cash, check, Visa, or Master Card. A credit card or additional check is required for a deposit (please see below). All renters must sign a UCSB *Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk & Indemnity Agreement*. Waiver Agreements are available online and at the rental center.

Children: Children are welcome and encouraged to participate. There are a few additional considerations for minors:

- A *Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk & Indemnity Agreement* must be signed by a parent or court appointed legal guardian. An adult responsible for a child that is not the child's parent or legal guardian may NOT sign on behalf of the child. Waiver Agreements are available online and at the rental center.
- Children under 12 must be in a tandem (2-person) kayak with an adult.
- No more than 2 people are allowed in a tandem kayak unless approved by Rental Center staff.
- All participants including children must wear a properly fitting and Coast Guard approved Personal Floatation Device (PFD) at all times on the water.
- An adult must accompany children 12-17 years old.

Late Fees: Any rental equipment returned late will be subject to an additional \$10 fee AND the next full hour or daily rate charge, whichever is less. An additional daily rate charge will be applied for every day the gear is not returned. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Deposit: Each rental item has a deposit fee, which is due in full at the time of rental with a credit card or additional check. Your deposit will be returned when all rental equipment is returned and any late fees, damage and/or wet/dirty fees have been assessed and paid in full. It may take up to one week to assess the damage fees. Campus departments using a recharge will not be required to place a deposit.

Damaged Equipment: Renters are responsible for the full repair costs of any damage. This includes any and all shipping, handling, and damage repair/replacement fees. We work with our suppliers to keep repair costs as low as possible. Any rental equipment returned misused or in poor condition is also subject to a \$10 cleaning fee per item. The assessment of the rental equipment condition upon its return is subject to the discretion of the rental staff facilitating the return. Once all fees have been paid, the deposit will be returned.

OVER

Responsibility: The renter is fully responsible for any and all equipment checked out and for its return in proper working condition as determined by the rental staff. Equipment must be returned clean and in good rental condition or a cleaning/damage fee will be assessed. An inventory number is assigned to each item. The renter is responsible for the condition of the item(s) assigned to them at checkout. Renters must return their own equipment. Do not trade rental equipment with others.

Parking on Campus: Parking is available in Lot #6. A parking permit is required. For parking fees and more UCSB parking information please visit tps.ucsb.edu.

Refund Policy: NO REFUNDS or credits will be made due to weather, road conditions, or equipment not picked up, unused or returned early. Only cancellations made by Adventure Programs will result in a refund.

Reservations: Groups larger than 8 individuals require a reservation at least two weeks in advance. Equipment for smaller groups and individuals will be available on a first come first served basis. We currently do not take reservations for individuals and/or small groups.

Personal Belongings: All personal belongings left on shore are NOT our responsibility. We can store small personal items at our Rental Center but ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE for any damage or loss. We cannot store any large items such as bikes, beach furniture, surfboards, etc.

For your comfort and safety: All paddlers/ riders must wear a Personal Floatation Device (PFD) at all times AND be able to swim. To make your experience more enjoyable, there are a few additional considerations:

- We recommend paddling in the Goleta Bay Area and/or close to the Campus and Isla Vista coast. Avoid paddling offshore and into the SB Channel as currents and high winds may take you out to sea, all the way down to Santa Barbara or beyond!!! Due to restoration and sensitive habitats, paddling in the Campus Lagoon is prohibited.
- We do not rent kayaks or other paddle craft for use at the Channel Islands due to liability restrictions. No exceptions.
- All kayaks come with PFDs, seats, and paddles. PFDs must be worn at all times on the water.
- Single-person kayak weight limit = 300 lbs. Tandem kayak weight limit = 450 lbs.
- Dress to get wet. A dry set of clothing for after paddling is highly recommended.
