UCSB Recreation Center Policies

The UCSB Recreation Center opened in 1995 and has become one of the most popular spots on campus. The original Rec Cen has two swimming pools, two gymnasias, two weight rooms, two squash courts and five racquetball courts. The Rec Cen Expansion (Rec Cen II) opened in the spring of 2005 and includes a weight room, multi-purpose gym, climbing wall, pottery studio, classroom, spa and additional locker facilities. **Patrons and staff are expected to follow all posted Rec Cen regulations.**

Students, Staff, Faculty, Guest Memberships and Day Pass Users:

- A picture ID is required to enter facility, purchase membership, or purchase a day pass.
- Staff, faculty and guests must sign a waiver of liability to enter the facility or purchase a membership or day pass.
- All minors must have a parent or legal guardian sign a waiver of liability.
- A charge will be assessed for a lost membership card.

Rec Cen Policies:

- Smoking is prohibited in all areas.
- Trespassing or access card fraud will result in loss of Rec Cen privileges.
- Threats or acts of violence will result in loss of Rec Cen privileges.
- Alcohol and drugs are prohibited.
- Court shoes are required in the fitness centers at all times: no open-toe shoes, boots, sandals, dress shoes, cleats, spikes, casts.
- Athletic attire is required at all times in the fitness centers: no denim jeans, jean shorts, pants with metal rivets, or belts.
- Bicycles, mopeds, unicycles, and rollerskates are not permitted in the Rec Cen and must be parked in a designated parking area. Skateboarding within the Rec Cen complex is prohibited. Rollerskating is limited to the indoor MAC rink.
- Day use shelves and lockers are provided for personal property. Please do not store valuables in these areas.
- Day use locks may be rented. Lockers, including lock & towel service, may also be rented on a quarterly or annual basis.
- The Recreation Center is not liable for lost or stolen items.
- Food and drink is permitted in designated areas only. Glass containers and gum are not permitted in the Rec Cen.
- Only UCSB Recreation instructors may conduct individual lessons, group classes or training sessions.
- Animals, including those on leash, are prohibited (exception: service animals).
- Photography or filming requires a University permit.
- Individual amplified sound is not permitted.
- The posting of flyers or newsletters is prohibited without prior permission.
- Special Events must be booked one quarter in advance. Student events require departmental or governance approval.
- Children 6 years of age and older should use their same sex locker room. For assistance, contact an on-duty supervisor.
- Rec Cen etiquette includes wiping down machines and mats after use.
- Rec Cen users are covered by UC and UCSB policies and procedures regarding Sexual Harassment. It is important that all Rec Cen patrons and staff feel comfortable using all of the facilities, and that they do not experience sexual harassment at any time. - UCSB Department of Recreation reserves the right to refuse admittance or sales of memberships or day passes, and reserves the right to revoke day pass and membership privileges when necessary.

Rec Cen Tour Policy

- Visitors touring the facility may not participate in any activity and must follow all policies while in the Rec Cen complex.
